### *Elementary School Educational Program*

**R**elive a family's day-to-day life from 1882 to the 1950s in the birthplace of this Canadian Prime Minister (1948 to 1957). In his father's general store, discover society in the area at the turn of the 20th century. Go back over the life and work of this great man in a multimedia presentation that will amaze you.

Five learning situations consistent with the *Québec Education Program* initiate your students to the past and to change in their society and the area around them. Exciting investigations, varied games and practical exercises let them discover and have fun!

#### First cycle

*My Needs* (Grade 1): basic needs since 1900.  
*My Everyday Life* (Grade 2): day-to-day life yesterday and today.  
*My Objects* (Grades 1 and 2): material culture since 1900.

#### Second cycle

*Conserving Yesterday, Consuming Today*: consumption and the environment since 1900.

#### Third cycle

*I am a Responsible Citizen*: democracy in our society yesterday and today.
