## **Rogers Pass National Historic Site**

FIRE PERMIT REQUIRED where fireboxes and firewood are provided. Boil water advisories may be posted.

The difficult and little-known terrain in the Selkirk Mountains **L** made finding a route for the Canadian Pacific Railway a demanding task. In 1882, surveyor A.B. Rogers traversed the 1323-metre pass that now bears his name. The last great obstacle facing the trans-continental railway had now been overcome. The steep grade

and avalanches made the pass such a treacherous part of the line that is was bypassed in 1916 by the Connaught Tunnel. Learn more about incredible Rogers Pass at exhibits throughout the
